SENATOR NEWELL: My opening argument was to bracket the bill and I never had a chance to close.

PRESIDENT: There was nothing to close to that I heard. Senator DeCamp just said that he agreed and Senator Cullan called for the question.

SENATOR NEWELL: You mean it is the order of the Legislature not to...closing is not right unless there has been debate or...is that right?

PRESIDENT: Yes, it's a debate but there was no answer to your opening statement.

SENATOR NEWELL: My motion, if it's not discussed...nobody understands it on the floor I still don't have a chance to close.

PRESIDENT: You have your opening statement, Senator.

SENATOR NEWELL: I'm asking for the right to close.

PRESIDENT: You have a right to answer, to reply to any answer but since there was no answer there is nothing to reply to. The question is the advancement of the bill. That will be by machine vote. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 7 nays Mr. President on motion to advance. Mr. President, read Standing Committee Reports from Government, Military and Veterans Affairs on pages 1058-1063 of the Journal. LB 44 placed on General File as amended. LB 229 indefinitely postponed. LB 250 indefinitely postponed. Signed Senator Rasmussen, Chairman. Mr. President the next bill on Select File is LB 283. Senator Fowler asked unanimous consent to lay it over and print amendments in the Journal. (Refer to pages 1063-1065).

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? So ordered. Senator Newell. (No response). Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move that the E & R amendments to LB 312 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President. I move that LB 312 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced. General File, LB 182.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 182 is a bill dealing with placement of solid waste disposal facilities. There are a series of amendments that have been adopted. There are a series of amendments pending. There is an amendment offered by...some other amendments have been disposed of. There is a Venditte amendment, Mr. President, that appears to be pending under date of February 21 on page 561 of the Legislative Journal. Then to that, there is a DeCamp amendment pending to amend the Venditte amendment. Pending is the Venditte amendment and then the DeCamp amendment to the Venditte amendment.
