LB 201, 494A

PRESIDENT: It will just be passed over, put on General File then.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Can we keep it on consent calendar.

PRESIDENT: That is up to the Speaker. What is your request, Senator Reutzel?

SENATOR REUTZEL: I would ask that it be laid over.

PRESIDENT: All right. We go to LB 494A. We have already advanced 494.

CLERK: LB 494A. Read title.

PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move adoption. This is the "A" bill that Senator Warner advised about yesterday saying that in 494 the \$30,000 went for former Senator Kennedy's office operation and really didn't go to the rest of the bill but to that and he specified that for us. So that is what it amounts to.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Senator Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I have just one real quick question, Senator Luedtke. This does not include any salary for the Director of that operation.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: As I understand it, he is a dollar a year man.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: That was the same question I had.

PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh. The question is the advancement of the "A" bill. Record your vote. Please vote. Record. Senator Luedtke, we can't get people to vote here. Senator Luedtke.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Do you want a Call?

PRESIDENT: They are here.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I will move for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: All right. The question is, shall we go under Call? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call. Go to your chair and record your presence and the Clerk can take votes.

CLERK: Senator Simon voting aye. Senator Keyes voted aye. Senator Maresh voting aye. Senator Fitzgerald voting aye.

PRESIDENT: And Senator Luedtke now moves to raise the Call.

CLERK: Senator Venditte voting aye.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the Call be raised?

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
