LB 228, 368, 482, 109

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, a request asked unanimous consent to bracket 228 until April 4. Signed Larry Stoney.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? Unanimous consent to bracket 228 until April 4. Seeing no objection, it's so ordered.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move that LB 368 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The nays have it, it's not advanced. No, it's the Chair's rule that the ayes did have that and it is advanced.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move the E & R amendments to LB 482 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I move that LB 482 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The ayes have it. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I move the E & R amendments to LB 109 be adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the E & R amendments have been adopted to 109, as well as a series of other amendments. There are a series of amendments which have been adopted. Mr. President, the first one up is offered by Senator Koch, who isn't present Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Before we get to that, do we have any specific amendments on 283? Would you take that one up first?

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move that LB 283...

CLERK: There are amendments.

PRESIDENT: Excuse me, there are amendments. I'm sorry. Then we better take them in order. I thought maybe if that was without amendments, we could move it. I interrupted you Mr. Clerk, who's amendment do you have on 109?

CLERK: Senator Koch's amendment, which he isn't present. He has an amendment found on page 1008 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Do you have any other amendments?

CLERK: Yes, I then have a motion from Senator DeCamp to indefinitely postpone 109.

PRESIDENT: Let's take up Senator DeCamp's amendment.

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
