

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move that the E & R amendments to LB 112 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 112 as amended be advanced to E & R Final.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.
