PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Swigart.

SENATOR SWIGART: Mr. Chairman and colleagues, this language is routine and in conformance with what you will remember a few days ago there was a little dispute or a little discussion between Senator Duis and I related to the language that ought to be in this bill pertaining to the sinking fund and he wrote out the proper wording that he has had long experience with and give me the wording and it changes nothing except makes it more legal language for sinking fund monies. So I move that the amendments be approved.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I want to thank Senator Swigart for accepting this amendment and I hope that it will be read in full because the other day when I held this bill up I took a little chiding around the floor here for the fact that I was holding up an Omaha piece of legislation when I wasn't from Omaha. But I am on the Urban Affairs Committee and this language that is in the bill now, I sincerely believe will take proper care of what they have in a sinking fund, whereas the previous language was not correct. So if those people from Omaha that thought I was interfering with them, I sincerely apologize to them and I hope that they will realize that this is the common language that is put in this type of bill so if the clerk will read the amendment, if he hasn't, in full, I think you will understand what the amendment is for.

CLERK: The amendment reads as follows: Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Frank Lewis, did you wish to be recognized. Do you want to close, Senator Swigart. All right. The question is the adoption of Senator Swigart's amendment. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, 23 present and not voting, 1 absent and not voting.

PRESIDENT: The motion is adopted. The amendment is adopted. Anything further, Mr. Clerk, on this?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move that LB 86 as amended be advanced to E & R Final.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move that LB 30 be advanced to E & R Final.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a request to bracket LB 30 to April 1.
