

Nebraska after they start a killing rampage. For example, a description of me could fit 500 people in the state of Nebraska but if they are trying to apprehend someone that is on a murder spree across the State of Nebraska, what they need is a photograph to circulate to all law enforcement agencies and let the law enforcement officers have something that they can recognize. Yes, I am me and they've got me. If we can stop a murderer running across the state of Nebraska one day sooner before he kills someone else, we will have paid a very negligible price for that benefit. For example, there is another benefit to this particular bill and that is that to all intensive purposes it will stop forgeries and alterations. For example, I've got several examples right here in the file. Anybody is welcome to come back and look at them of Nebraska forged drivers' licenses. They are as phony as a three dollar bill and yet they are being printed and sold right here in the State of Nebraska for \$8 a piece. If we can, by adopting this type of drivers' license, stop the kids from buying a forged or altered drivers' license and stop them from getting booze in their hands and killing themselves, we will have another benefit for this bill, from this bill rather, that will have well been worth the quarter or 25¢ per year. In the bill itself, we have provided that the Department of Motor Vehicles is the boss. They are going to administer this bill with rules and regulations and that they have an advisory committee made up of three county treasurers and two laypersons. Those five people review with the Department of Motor Vehicles director how this shall be implemented. We have made the Department of Motor Vehicles the boss. Now, a while ago, I had circulated a cost break-down sheet on this bill. You'll notice if you refer to that, that there are about 315,000 drivers' licenses issued each year. We are going to increase in this bill; we're going to increase the amount that the county treasurers get of the proceeds of the drivers' license from 20% to 25%. Out of the 315,000 that comes in at \$1.00 per drivers' license, county treasurers will get \$78,000 spread among the counties. That leaves a balance of \$236,250. The statutes now provide that 50% of the balance goes to the driver education fund at the State Department of Education. So \$118,125 will go out to the high schools to help defer the costs of driver education in the high schools. The balance, the other 50% of the net proceeds \$118,000 goes to the state general fund. 315,000 drivers' licenses at 35¢ per drivers' license for each photo comes to \$110,000 so consequently the state has a net profit on this particular bill of \$7,875. There is no cost to the general fund, in fact, the general fund makes a small profit. With that I will be willing to answer any questions anybody has.
