LB 126, 401, 462, 473, 77

ASSISTANT CLERK: Continued reading vote.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Simon, are you voting? Announce the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 36 ayes, 9 nays, 3 excused and not voting, and 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 126 passes. Clerk will read LB 401 on Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 401.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read vote on page 1166 of the Journal. Senator Merz voting aye. 46 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 401 passes with the emergency clause attached. Will the Clerk read on Final Reading LB 462.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 462.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read vote on page 1167 of the Journal. 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 462 passes. Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 473.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 473.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read vote on page 1168 of the Journal.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Nichol voting aye.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 49 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: This is probably a first for this session, all 49 voting in favor of a bill. The bill passes. We'll now revert back to LB 77, Mr. Clerk. There is a motion, I believe, on the desk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The motion, Mr. President, is to bracket LB 77. Signed Senator Jack Mills.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Chair recognizes Senator Jack Mills.
