LB 248, 511, 512

CLERK: Mr. President. Read Standing Committee Reports from Public Works on page 1170 of the Journal. LB 248 placed on General File as amended. Mr. President, Banking gives notice of a cancellation of executive session today. Signed Senator DeCamp. That's all Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: We next have in order of the agenda, special order on Appropriations bills. Senator Warner are you prepared to handle the Appropriations bills. The Clerk read the title to LB 511.

CLERK: Read LB 511. There are committee amendments by Senator Warner's Appropriations Committee to add the emergency clause.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the committee amendment to LB 511 which increases the cash fund that is available at the Aerospace Museum at Bellevue currently at the limit that they can have on hand is \$400. The increase is to \$1,000. They have a variety...the attendance is increasing, \$400 requires they go to the bank two or three times a day sometimes. At the peak season, it's a matter of convenience that it should be raised.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: This is on the committee amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: The committee amendment is just the emergency clause.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Koch, did you wish to speak to the attaching of the emergency clause? (No response). The question then is the adoption of the committee amendment of adding the emergency clause. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on motion to adopt.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The committee amendment is adopted. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 511 be advanced to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion then is the advancement of LB 511 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 511 is advanced to E & R Initial. LB 512.

CLERK: Read LB 512. There are committee amendments, Mr. President, by the Appropriations Committee. Signed by Senator Warner.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Chair recognizes Senator Warner.
