SENATOR F. LEWIS: That is very technical that you can do that, but you can't speak to it because that wouldn't be the motion.

SENATOR DWORAK: Very good.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: The question is unanimous consent to lay over, until tomorrow, LR 34. Is there objection? Senator Lewis.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Mr. President, what order, could you have the Speaker inform me in what order that would come up tomorrow? The order of business.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Well we'll have the hour in the morning, At least an hour will be provided for LB 64, that will follow Final Reading. I don't know just exactly how long Final Reading will take, probably about half an hour again. So we'll be into 10:30 before we get on to resolutions and motions. So it will be probably about 11 o'clock in the morning.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: If this is promised, then I have no objections.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Are there other objections? Hearing no other objections, unanimous consent to lay over LR 34 is granted. We now go to Select File. Mr. Speaker.

(Speaker Luedtke presiding)

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: On Select File, Senator Schmit is excused for the afternoon, so we'll go over LB 425. Let's do that. Senator Cullan, we can adopt the E & R amendments to LB 425 and then hold it. Senator Cullan, we didn't hear you. LB 425.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I move that the E & R amendments to LB 425 be adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion has been made to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 425. Any discussion? All those in favor of the E & R amendments to LB 425 say aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments to LB 425 are adopted.

CLERK: Okay now, Mr. President, there is a motion offered by Senator Schmit to amend.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: That will lay over until tomorrow then. We'll proceed then with LB 124. Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I move that the E & R amendments to LB 124 be adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 124. Any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to LB 124 say aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted. Senator Cullan.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there is a unanimous consent request by Senator Fowler to bracket 124 until April 5th.
