

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection to Senator Savage asking that these be acting upon together? Seeing none, make your motion.

SENATOR SAVAGE: I move the approval of Mr. William E. Peters to the reappointment to the Code of Ethics Board and to Mr. Donald Treadway of Fullerton to the Code of Ethics Board. I would like to point out that this board will be phased out the 1st of July if this other commission is approved. Mr. Norman L. Stadler of Valley, appointment to the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board. I move their approval.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: Read vote on pages 1200-1201 of the Journal. Senator Marsh voting aye. Senator Rumery voting aye. 28 ayes, 0 nays, 21 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Those three nominees are confirmed. Anything further Senator Savage? Thank you, Senator. Resolutions. Legislative Resolution No. 34.

CLERK: Mr. President, Legislative Resolution No. 34 was before us yesterday. It's found on page 930 of the Legislative Journal. There is pending a motion by Senator Dworak as follows. (Refer to page 1181). That motion was pending when we quit.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President and colleagues. I'd like unanimous consent to withdraw that motion.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? Seeing none, it's so ordered. Do you have anything further Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: ...offered by Senator Richard Lewis. Page 931 of the Journal. Read amendment on page 1201 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richard Lewis.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I would move adoption of the amendment. This, as you recall from the conversation yesterday, there was some differences of opinion as to how this matter should be handled and there was a lot of discussion about LB 100 being held in position on the board. This amendment is a moratorium that has been approved by both the rurals and the municipalities. It is a compromise that has been agreed upon by all concerned and it is with their approval that I'm asking for this amendment. I would like to state further that if and when this amendment is adopted and the resolution is accepted by a majority vote of the elected members, then I have also on the desk a motion to ask unanimous consent to withdraw LB 100. This is part of a package deal that we worked out in this compromise. Unless there are further questions, I would move adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, colleagues. Senator Lewis' proposal on the desk...I'm in total agreement with it. I know Senator Lewis spent many hours last night and many hours this early morning working out this particular compromise.
