Maresh. Do you have an objection?

CLERK: He is the one who made the motion.

PRESIDENT: Oh, I am sorry. I thought....

CLERK: I am sorry. It is DeCamp who made the motion.

PRESIDENT: Yes. Seeing none, it is so ordered. Now, LB 302. Senator Brennan's bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 302 is indefinitely postponed or the motion was made to indefinitely postpone it so it is automatically laid over.

PRESIDENT: I guess we have disposed of it. If it is indefinitely postponed, that is laid over then. Yes. Senator Brennan.

SENATOR BRENNAN: I think Senator Murphy might have done me a favor.

PRESIDENT: We go to General File.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 498. There are E & R amendments. There are, yes.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Speaker, would you move the E & R amendments?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments to LB 498.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that LB 498 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. It is advanced. We go to General File. LB 90, Senator Goodrich's bill. Where is Senator Goodrich? Mr. Speaker, let's go to LB 398 while we are waiting for Senator Goodrich. What about it, Senator Kahle?

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. President, I ask for unanimous consent to bracket LB 398 until April 5th.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? Seeing none, it is so ordered. LB 483, Urban Affairs. 483. Just a minute, Senator George. Do you want to handle this bill today, Senator?

SENATOR GEORGE: Yes.

PRESIDENT: All right. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Duis has amendments on 483 and he is not here. He has left.

PRESIDENT: Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. President, I discussed it with Senator Duis just before lunch and he said he would be back for the amendments.

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
