

SENATOR BARNETT: Is Senator Reutzel in the Chamber? Senator Stoney, would you care to comment on this while we're....

SENATOR STONEY: Senator Barnett, it's not an amendment, I'm sure, that Senator Reutzel will be opposed to. So that we might progress here and move along, I assure you that I'm not attempting to do anything that is out of order. If we cannot handle it since Senator Reutzel is not here, then I would ask that we move to consider this rather than unanimous consent.

SENATOR BARNETT: Senator Stoney, you can't have unanimous consent, you'll have to make a motion to return it anyway. We do it under those circumstances.

SENATOR STONEY: Then I would so move that the bill be returned for the addition of this amendment, please.

SENATOR BARNETT: The motion is to return. Senator Reutzel, did you care to be heard? Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, it's simply a clarifying amendment, Senator Reutzel, that we're putting on to straighten out the MUD Board for Bellevue, which has no affect on what you're trying to do in the bill. I'd support the return of the bill.

SENATOR BARNETT: Senator Stoney, do you have any close? The motion is to return LB 201 to Select for a specific amendment. All in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Senator Barnett voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Barnett voting aye.

SENATOR BARNETT: Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on motion to return.

SENATOR BARNETT: Would you read the motion.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, the motion is to adopt the Stoney specific amendment to LB 201.

SENATOR BARNETT: Senator Stoney, do you wish to say anything or not?

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. President, the Clerk may wish to read the amendment, since I did not have an opportunity to have it printed in the Journal.

SENATOR BARNETT: Please read the amendment.

CLERK: Read amendment.

SENATOR BARNETT: Senator Stoney.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the amendment, please.

SENATOR BARNETT: Anymore discussion? You've heard the amendment. All those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Clerk will record. Motion is adopted. Anything else, Mr. Clerk?
