However, you are pledging the full faith and credit of every citizen in that municipality for the benefit, perhaps, of a single subdivider. Certainly you're pledging it for a subdivision as it is built through a water and sewer district if you permit the addition of these words to our statutes in unprecedented fashion, the words general obligation. Therefore, I move that you bracket this bill and give an opportunity for counsel by the people who perhaps you will trust if you won't trust us.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Question then is the Bereuter motion to bracket LB 483 until April 14th. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? I am about to recognize Senator Bereuter. It still takes 75 votes to bracket this bill. Senator Bereuter.

SENATOR BEREUTER: Mr. President, I'm not going to move for a...I'll just let the votes fall where they may on the next one.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Alright. Record the vote.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 11 nays.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to bracket fails. Any further amendments?

CLERK: None.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. President, I move the advancement of the bill to E & R initial.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to advance LB 483 to E & R initial. Any further discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 16 nays.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The bill does not advance. It remains where it is.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a communication from myself to the Governor requesting that he return LB 419. There is a letter from Mr. Hoppner, Administrative Assistant to the Governor, returning LB 419. There is a letter from myself to the Speaker advising the Legislature that LB 419 is now before the Legislature again. Mr. President, a motion on the desk. I move we reconsider our action on final passage of LB 419. Signed, Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: 419? Oh yes. Chair recognizes Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, if I could have some help from the Clerk, what is the proper procedural request?

CLERK: The motion is to reconsider our action on final reading. Once that carries you can bracket it there until you get your amendment prepared.
