PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAFLIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Legislature will come to order. Roll call. Record your presence please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Boughn and Senator Swigart asked to be excused till they arrive. Senator Simon asked to be excused till he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Please record your presence. Have you all recorded your presence? Record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: (Read corrections found on page 1372 of the Journal).

PRESIDENT: Are there further corrections from the floor? Seeing none, the Journal shall stand as corrected. Notices, reports and announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 36 and find the same correctly enrolled, 283 correctly enrolled, 324 correctly enrolled, 353 correctly enrolled, 511 correctly enrolled, 513 correctly enrolled, 514 correctly enrolled, LR 46 correctly enrolled, LR 50 correctly enrolled, LR 52 correctly enrolled, and LR 53 correctly enrolled.
