SENATOR DWORAK: Yes, I'll direct the question.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Kahle, you want to answer the question.

SENATOR KAHLE: Yes, I think I can answer it. The bill was introduced last week, LB 527, which would have given the Game and Parks Commission permission to acquire this same property that I'm talking about. A committee hearing is set for tomorrow at 12:30. So there is a committee hearing set. What I'm asking now is that we go ahead with the hearing. If it's permissible then to re-enter the resolution on about Friday and take another....

SENATOR DWORAK: Senator Kahle, does this bill do exactly what the resolution does? We're talking about the same procedure and the same piece of property.

SENATOR KAHLE: It's the same piece of property. It has exactly the same legal description in the bill as it does in the resolution, yes. There is a little bit of difference in the way the property is going to be accepted, we have found out that the bill could easily be made to fit either way.

SENATOR DWORAK: So what you're saying then is if the committee in its wisdom decides to not advance the bill to general file then we can come in with a resolution and let the body sort of circumvent the wishes of the committee. It's a little bit of insurance type of situation.

SENATOR KAHLE: Well I had really been thinking of it the other way. Should they find that there was not that much opposition, if they wanted to advance the bill....

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Chambers, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, this is a unanimous consent, not a motion. I don't think the debate is in order.

SENATOR MARVEL: Do you object to the unanimous consent motion, Senator Dworak? Is there any objection to the unanimous consent motion? If not, so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 7 in the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR MARVEL: No objection, so ordered.
