

SENATOR MARVEL: There is no other discussion. Do you have the request there? Do you have the explanation of the request? You want to read it. The motion is to give the committee permission to have the bill introduced. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting aye, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on motion to introduce.

SENATOR MARVEL: Motion is carried. The bill is introduced. Do you have anything else on the desk.

CLERK: I need to read the bills in, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: Alright.

CLERK: Read title to LB 534 and 535. That is all, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: The next motion is we have Senator Cope's motion, then we have Senator Chambers motion. Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: Mr. President, I would like unanimous consent to hold this over until after lunch. I think it will take longer. I see people leaving now. I'd like unanimous consent.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there any objection? Senator Cope asks for unanimous consent to lay over 79 and 79A till the first order of business this afternoon. Is that right?

SENATOR COPE: Yes.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there any objection? If not, so ordered. Senator Chambers. If there is no objections the motion on LB 62 will be laid over until the second order of business this afternoon. I want to change the order to this extent, unless there is objection, LB 45 was replaced on Select File for the purpose of reading amendments. Are we ready to act on LB 45 so that it can be acted upon, advanced and then brought back by at least...there is a kill motion on 45, but this has to be done because the E & R requested this. Can you proceed with LB 45, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Yes. Senator Cullan.

SENATOR MARVEL: Chair recognizes Senator Cullan for E & R amendments to LB 45. We're now on Select File.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I move the E & R amendments to LB 45 be adopted.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a second? All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted. Are we ready to advance the bill now, Vince? Move to advance the bill.
