

SENATOR SAVAGE: Only two that I know of, Senator Boughn and Senator Nichol have been excused.

CLERK: There are four excused.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Four excused. Senator Luedtke is excused because he is out of town.

SENATOR KEYES: Hasn't it always been the policy of the Legislature that if a man's bill came up on Select File and he wasn't here that we just put it on to General File at the bottom of the list. Let's start doing that once and then these men will be here until it comes to mv bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 91 can come up. There are no amendments on the bill. The last request was to bracket it till April 12th which was done and there is not nothing further pending.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Vince, there is suppose to be an amendment hanging on this bill relative to blenders. Wasn't it given to you? Vince, you do not have an amendment?

CLERK: We are checking. It is not on the bill. No, we have no amendment.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Senator Kahle, do you have that amendment we were talking about? I will tell you what. Let's just advance the bill and let it go at that. We won't offer the amendment right now.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 91 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR SAVAGE: All in favor say aye. Opposed. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next one is LB 510. There were no E & R amendments. Senator Murphy offered an amendment which has been pending from March 29th, March 31st, April 1st and April 6th.

CLERK: Senator Murphy, on LB 510 you had an amendment to amend LB 510, page 14, lines 19 and 20, strike "in carrying on its operations" and insert "for the purposes set forth in this act".
