SENATOR SAVAGE: There is no further discussion. The question is the return of LB 196 for specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Do you wish to be recognized, Senator Chambers? Will you please vote. Please vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record. Senator Simon.

SENATOR SIMON: Yes, I am going to ask for a Call of the House, please?

SENATOR SAVAGE: Do I see five hands? The question is a Call of the House. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 1 nay.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The House is under Call. Will the Sergeant at Arms secure the Senators. Return to your seats. Please indicate your presence, please. Senator Duis. Senator Nichol. Frank Lewis. Senator Brennan, will you record your presence, please. Senator Dworak. Senator Kelly, will you check in please. Senator Koch. Senator Cone, will you check in with us, please.

CLERK: Senator Dworak voting aye on the original motion. Senator Savage voting aye on the original motion. Senator Reutzel voting aye on the original motion. Senator Venditte voting aye on the original motion.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Goodrich.

CLERK: Senator DeCamp said, I think, aye.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Merz.

CLERK: Senator Keyes voting aye.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Goodrich voting aye. A move to raise the Call. All those in favor say aye.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to raise the Call.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The Call is raised.

CLERK: 27 ayes and 9 nays on the original motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, the bill has been returned. The motion now would be the adoption of this specific amendment on Select File.

SENATOR SAVAGE: That has to lay over a day, doesn't it?

CLERK: No.

SENATOR SAVAGE: It doesn't? Senator Simon.
