CLERK: 17 ayes, 5 nays to go under Call.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call. Please return to your desks and record your presence. Would you all take the trouble of punching your green button right now, to let us know that you are here. We are under Call Senator DeCamp. We are under Call. Senator Clark moves that the Call be raised. Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: I would like to have a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Call the roll.

SENATOR NEWELL: How many people are here right now?

PRESIDENT: We have all but one. Call the roll.

CLERK: Read amendment. Roll call vote. 25 ayes, 15 nays 2 present and not voting, 7 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 1408 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Motion passes. Senator Clark moves that the Call be raised. Record your vote on that matter. Record.

CLERK: 22 ayes and 1 nay to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. In the north balcony we have fifty fourth grade students from Howard School in Grand Island. That is in Senator Kelly's district. We hope that you students have a good time this day in the Capitol Building. Thank you for being with us.
