ASSISTANT CLERK: Read title to LB 124.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 124 pass. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read record vote found on pages 1422 and 1423 of the Journal. 41 ayes, 0 nays, 8 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 124 passes. Please read LB 173.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read title to LB 173.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 173 pass. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read record vote found on page 1423 of the Journal. 37 ayes, 1 nay, 8 excused and not voting, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 173 passes. Please read.... First of all, we have in the North balcony 25 third grade to senior high students from Norfolk Warnerville Ranger 4-H Club members. We're glad to have that group. Would you stand please. Thank you. That is from Senator Boughn's district. LB 238.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Motion on the desk, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

ASSISTANT CLERK: I move to return LB 238 to Select File for specific amendment. The specific amendment reads as follows: (Read Savage amendment found on page 1393 of the Journal).

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. There has been some concern by some people about removing older residents from their homes to create a parking area. I put this amendment in to prevent this sort of thing from taking place. I move the bill be returned for this specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question then is shall this bill be returned for the specific amendment. Record your vote. Record.
