ruled, I would like to see us proceed after lunch and get as much work done as we can. Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers, may I ask you first of all, are you closing now so that we can vote on this before we go off of it?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes. I would like to vote on this. Mr. Chairman, if I could get the members to listen just for an instant, and we can vote on this very quickly. I would like my amendments to not go all the way through pages 180 and 181. Section 237, Section 238 and Section 239 are provisions that deal with bestiality and other things that perhaps should be some place. I would like my amendment to strike Article 10 with the exception of Sections 237, 238 and 239. If I can do that without a vote, that is what I would like.

SENATOR MARVEL: Okay. The Chair will consider that your amendment is amended.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Alright. So here is what is being done now. Only the things that I have discussed with you already are what would be stricken. All of the material related to bestiality, cruelty to animals and indecent things would still be left where they sit now. In order not to take a long time, I hope that you will vote to strike this provision.

SENATOR MARVEL: The question is the adoption of the Chambers motion which strikes Article 10 up to Section 237 on page 180. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting aye, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays.

SENATOR MARVEL: Motion carried. The amendments is adopted. We will move off of this special order, and do you have anything you want to read in?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR MARVEL: Okay, you read it in, then I'm going to recognize Senator Kahle on LR 54.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bereuter asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 38A. Senator Kelly asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 121, and have them printed in the Journal.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is that it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No. Senator Nichol asks unanimous consent to print some amendments to LB 121. Now, Mr. President, your Committee on Appropriations to whom was referred LB 522 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File as amended.
