PRESIDENT: Alright. The question is shall the House go under Call. Record your vote on that. Record.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 4 nays to go under Call.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call. All senators please return to your desks and record your presence so that we can commence the roll. Please record your presence as quickly as possible. Senator Reutzel. Senator Labeledz. Senator Savage. Senator Nichol. Senator Frank Lewis. Senator Mills. Senator Boughn. Would the Sergeant at Arms please find Senator Chambers and Senator Schmit. Senator DeCamp, record your presence. We are under Call. Would the Sergeant at Arms please contact Senator Chambers office. We are under Call, senators. We are under Call. Does the Sergeant at Arms have a report as to Senator Chambers? Senator Koch, Senator Merz has been excused for the day, and Senator Chambers is not in his office and they can't find him. May we commence the roll? You asked for a roll call vote. Do you want us to commence the roll?

SENATOR KOCH: Please.

PRESIDENT: Alright, commence the roll.

CLERK: (Took roll call vote found on page 1467 of the Journal). 25 ayes, 19 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Retirement to whom is referred LB 2, instructs me to report the same indefinitely postponed. LB 347 General File as amended, 349 General File as amended. Signed, Senator Hasebroock. Mr. President, your committee on Appropriations to whom is referred 520, instructs me to report the same legislation be advanced to General File as amended. Signed, Senator Warner. Public Works refers 247 to General File as amended. 429 indefinitely postponed, Signed, Senator Kremer. Mr. President, Senator Bereuter offers 450A introduced by Senator Bereuter, a bill for an act to appropriate funds in carrying the provisions of LB 450 of the 45th Legislature, First Session. And Senator Bereuter offers amendments to 450 and Senator Warner offers amendments to 531. Thank you, Mr. President.
