LB 90A, 459, 459A

SENATOR DE CAMP: Mr. President, I will talk it to death and I don't want too. Vote.

PRESIDENT: Okay, the question is shall the legislature reconsider its action in its failure to pass LB 90A.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 9 nays and 10 not voting on the motion to reconsider.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Okay, now we have to do this routine one more time so I have no opening or closing.

PRESIDENT: We are now on Final Reading. All senators please return to your desks. Please return to your desks.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Mr. President, this did pass didr't it.

PRESIDENT: The motion to reconsider requires the same vote, so you have voted to reconsider your action. I beg your pardon?

CLERK: Read LB90A.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, 'Shall LB 90A pass?' Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 11 nays, 6 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 1492 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: LB 90 A passes. That completes Final Reading, I think. We now go to Item B, Senator Warner's motion that LB459 and 459A become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor. Senator Warner.
