

CLERK: Mr. President we have a series of amendments offered by Senator Chambers. These are found on pages 1464 and 1465 of the Journal. I don't know how many of them you want to take at one time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: One at a time.

CLERK: Alright. Amendment number one is found on page 1464 of the Journal, it reads as follows (read amendment).

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature. Some of these amendments I have talked to with Senator Barnett and he has no objection, and he may want to make a statement with reference to adopting a small group of these at one point. They could be considered for the purpose of clarification and they did not generate controversy so I will let him address himself to the ones that he would not see any objection too.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Barnett has a motion to amend the Chambers amendment to include one, seven and eight. I presume that you mean those three in one motion?

SENATOR BARNETT: Right. I would move for the adoption of the amendment to Senator Chambers amendment to adopt one, seven and eight if you can follow us on the sheet. They are on page 1464 in the Journal. He passed this amendments out to you yesterday. We found nothing wrong with some of the others that he had in there too except for explanation on his point and I have talked to Senator Chambers and there are a few that he would like to hold back for points of clarification. We would like to do this with some expediency because I would like to get this code underway and take a vote and get it moved forward this morning. I would move that we adopt one, seven and eight to these amendments that he has. He can explain one, seven is the accountability for the State Patrol to the drug control cash fund, I think that it makes a lot of sense. They probably do quite a bit of it right now. The only question that we had with this is that we might have had it in the wrong section of law in the criminal code. It might be better under the State Patrol, rules and regs or statutes that govern the State Patrol. We have talked about that. At least we know that it would be somewhere in law that we have accountability to the drug control cash fund and on page eight or the other amendment eight would deal with the property division of law enforcement agencies and say that property ceased would go into that area which is under the control of the property division officer. With that I would ask for those three amendments to be adopted in a group setting and then we can go ahead with the others.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers has no objection to that?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No.

PRESIDENT: Is there any other objection? Alright, it is so ordered. Did you make a motion or did you request unanimous consent.

SENATOR BARNETT: I would ask unanimous consent if I could, but I thought I had to make a motion.
