CLERK: Read Fowler amendment.

SENATOR MARVEL: All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting on the Fowler amendment to the Duis amendment. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays.

SENATOR MARVEL: The Fowler amendment has been adopted. We are now on the Duis amendment as amended.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, I have more Fowler amendments. (Read Fowler amendment)

SENATOR FOWLER: I'll withdraw that.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there any objection? So ordered. Do you have another?

CLERK: No that is all. Now we have the basic Duis amendment as amended.

SENATOR MARVEL: Okay, Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move for the adoption of the amendment as amended.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a second? You have heard the motion and the second. Senator Duis, do you wish to close?

SENATOR DUIS: Only to say that Senator Fowler I know is attempting to do a great thing for the State of Nebraska with this energy bill and all I would be in hopes of doing together with the other folks is to help with the situation so that we might have a strong energy office.

SENATOR MARVEL: You have heard the motion and the second. The vote is on the Duis amendment as amended to LB232. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. It takes 25. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes and 0 nays on the motion to adopt.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is adopted. Senator Cullan for what purpose do you arise? Are you ready to advance the bill?

CLERK: No, no, no. Read Venditte amendment.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Venditte, do you move the adoption of your amendment?

SENATOR VENDITTE: Yes, I do Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a second? Motion has been moved and seconded Senator Venditte.
