LB 232, 33, 539, 238

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays.

SENATOR MARVEL: Are there any.....

SENATOR VENDITTE: Mr. President,

SENATOR MARVEL: Motion is carried, amendment is adopted.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Oh, I'm sorry. Thank you.

SENATOR MARVEL: Are there any other amendments to LB232?

CLERK: None.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Fowler are you ready to advance the bill.

SENATOR FOWLER: Yes, I'll forego my moving energy crisis speech. I would say that...to point out to people that this is on Select File. Someone made reference that maybe we should amend this on Select File. It is already there. So, people may consider that if there are other amendments. With the Duis amendment as amended by Senator Bereuter this legislature can still this session, if it wishes, create a separate energy office. In fact, I'll check with our fiscal staff to get an amendment drafted that if someone wants to present to do that, we can so that we can discuss, I think that the bill is maybe clearer now thanks to the amendments. I would ask that it be advanced.

SENATOR MARVEL: I would like to break in, I'm not sure if this is the group leaving in the north balcony we have 40 6th grade students from Syracuse, Nebraska. Where are you? Oh, there you are. We welcome you with Mrs. Marvin Shockt your teacher, this is Senator Carsten's district. We are ready to vote on the advancement of 232. All those in favor say aye, no, we need 25 votes. Alright, okay, all those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. Motion carried, bill is advanced.

SENATOR MARVEL: I wish to introduce two guests, in the upper balcony on the north side is Mr. John Turner who is a friend of Senator Swigart's who lives in Senator Stoney's district. Will you raise your hand so that we can recognize you. Welcome to the Legislature.

Now, I think Senator Savage we should go to LB238, adopt E & R amendments and advance the bill. So, I think your other amendments and there will be a motion later to bring it back.
