

possibility of a decline in ADM where that school may benefit to a small degree from that but after '79 this amendment would not be applicable when all new evaluations are certified, When we get right on like we always do it.

SENATOR MURPHY: You don't believe the affect is going to be substantive?

SENATOR KOCH: I would believe it would be negligible, Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Thank you.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any further discussion on the Koch amendment number 2. All those in favor...the motion before the House is the adoption of the Koch amendment number 2. Senator Koch, would you care to close?

SENATOR KOCH: I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All those in favor of the Koch amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Koch amendment number 2 is adopted. Read the next amendment, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: The next amendment, Mr. President, is again offered by Senator Koch found on page 1533 of the Legislative Journal identified as amendment number 3.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Before I recognize Senator Koch, I would like to recognize in the North Balcony 8 teachers, visitors from the state of California from San Jose, California from Gunderson High school. Would these 8 teachers please honor us by standing up and being recognized. Welcome to the Unicameral Legislature to the state of Nebraska. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, members of the body. This amendment pertains actually to the amendment we just adopted. I alluded to it a moment ago. I advise you that under the whole harmless provisions we just adopted that this whole harmless and I'll give you the example that I'm looking at possibly. We can't always be assured the Legislature would appropriate \$20 million next year and yet we have said those schools receive no less. What we're saying here, the Legislature shall at least appropriate the amount of money necessary for those schools so that they will not suffer a decrease in state aid which could be a several million dollar appropriation rather than a \$20 million appropriation. That is what this amendment does and that is why it refers back to the section before. I ask for the adoption of the amendment.
