

SENATOR KOCH: Only that amount necessary to meet the whole harmless clause. Those schools would be losing aide out of their new evaluations.

SENATOR CULLAN: We have absolutely no projections of what that might be?

SENATOR KOCH: I can't predict that, Senator Cullan, because we don't yet know what the county is going to certify as their new evaluation when they complete their reappraisals. It says only that amount necessary to meet the intent of the amendment we just adopted, Senator Cullan, which could be I'm sure considerably less than the \$20 million that we have asked for in the bill for the following year.

SENATOR CULLAN: Thank you very much Senator Koch.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any further discussion on the Koch amendment number 3? If not, Senator Koch, would you care to close?

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion before the House is the adoption of the Koch amendment number 3. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Adoption of the Koch amendment number 3 to LB 33. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker, if we don't get our 25 votes right now, I'm going to have to ask for a call of the House.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Koch amendment number three is adopted.

CLERK: The next section, Mr. President, is offered by Senator Murphy to amend LB 33. Read. (See page 1566, Journal.)

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Senator Koch says he has another amendment in that other series.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: That will do this?

CLERK: I have no further Koch amendments.

SENATOR MURPHY: All right, while he is researching that, I will go back to section 4,160. This is an amendment that would cover the ten million dollars that apparently has been absorbed within this bill. We are dedicating 75 million this year which is the former 45 and 10 million and yet that 10 million authorization still stands in our statutes under 4,160 and I have serious question in my mind. I know the Appropriation...I should say, I understand the Appropriations Committee has, in fact, appropriated another 10 million, so added to the 75 million, we are up to 85 million and I think if we are going to appropriate that 10 million that was previously under 4,160 as part of the 75, then we should strike 4,160 before we suddenly
