SENATOR KEYES: ...and everyone that cooks in the kitchen, and everything else.

SENATOR GOODRICH: After July 1, 1978.

SENATOR KEYES: It is mandatory that they are going to be a part of the pension plan?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I am confused here. As I read this, this does not apply to those type of people. This applies to people like, for example, doctors or professional people for ESUs and so forth. Now, Senator Goodrich, am I clear off the track here?

SENATOR GOODRICH: It is referring to those noncertified employees which is nonteachers. It is anybody else other than the board members.

SENATOR NICHOL: I don't know. Are you sure of this?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes, that is what noncertified means.

SENATOR NICHOL: I understood that this had to do with people who were professional people, not janitors and people like you are speaking who are employed by ESUs or at times by ESUs, who a few of them wanted in on this and some of them didn't want in on it. Now am I on the wrong deal?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, I am going to suggest that we skip this until the two expert school people are back, that is, Senator Lewis and Senator Koch. Maybe if either one of them get back, they are both very familiar with this type of thing. Let them explain it.

SENATOR NICHOL: I have no objection to that but I do feel that we should have clarification as to what type of employees we are talking about here and I certainly don't mean to embarrass you, Senator Goodrich, at all.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Senator Koch is back. Maybe we can ask him a question. Senator Koch, is a noncertified employee of the school system other than teachers?

SENATOR KOCH: That is correct. It is custodians, those types of people. They are noncertified. The people with the degrees are called classified, professional.

SENATOR NICHOL: Are the people such as those performing psychiatric examinations for ESUs and so forth in this bill?

SENATOR KOCH: No.

SENATOR NICHOL: Okay, fine, thank you.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Goodrich, do you care to close?

SENATOR GOODRICH: We have thoroughly discussed it. I move the bill advance.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion is the advance of LB 349 to F & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are
