SENATOR DUIS: A question of Senator Warner, if I might. Senator Warner.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Warner, will you respond.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR DUIS: I have a hard time seeing you but what I am interested in, you have taken out of 532, then, the language that you put in there in reference to the Diagnostic Center and you put it over in 539, is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes. There may be a question of whether it can be in there, too.

SENATOR DUIS: Now, in order for me to object to what you have in 539, I can make a request to have 539 have a public hearing now, can't I?

SENATOR WARNER: Pardon?

SENATOR DUIS: I will visit with you about it later but you have it out of 532?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR DUIS: Thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: That is the committee amendments, Senator Duis, page 13, where it shows the language on page 60, 18 through 27, as being stricken and on page 70, lines 1 through 8.

SENATOR DUIS: Yes, I think that is correct. Thank you very much.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Bereuter. Senator Warner, there is no further debate. Will you close on the committee amendments, then?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Warner, does that complete your...

SENATOR WARNER: Yes. I think the committee amendments can be adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: So the motion then is to adopt the committee amendments on LB 532. All those in favor of adopting the committee amendments vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays. Mr. President, Senator Warner also offers some additional amendments to the committee amendment. These are found on page 1548.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: You gave me the vote, didn't you? 29 ayes. The committee amendments are adopted. Now, proceed.

CLERK: Senator Warner offers some additional committee amendments found on page 1548 of the Journal.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: 1548 of the Journal, and these are additional committee amendments submitted by Senator Warner.

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
