LB 504, 347

PRESIDENT: Discussion? The question is the adoption of Senator Maresh's amendment regarding the constitutional amendments being adopted. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted, Senator Maresh.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there is an amendment offered by Senator Warner which reads as follows: (Read amendment found on page 1725 of the Journal).

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. The Appropriations Committee approved the committing of this amendment to 504 this morning. What this is is a paving assessment. Apparently some roads have been improved bordering the state property at Kearney. This was the assessment for that paving, \$45,117.20. As I understand it was submitted to the Claims Board after their report had gone to the Labor & Business Committee, and it was submitted to us. We felt it was appropriate that it would be put in LB 504 as a committee amendment, rather than one of the other appropriation bills. Obviously, the state has to meet this commitment. I would move its adoption. It's all General Fund money.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is Senator Warner's amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays. That is all the amendments.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Do you want to move the bill, Senator Maresh?

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, the total amount of this bill amounts to, for those that wish to keep track, amounts to \$328,564 from the General Fund, and \$2,274 from the cash fund, for a total of \$330,837. If there are any questions I'll be glad to answer on any of these claims before we advance the bill. All these have been approved by the Claims Board or by the Appropriations Committee. No questioning. I move that LB 504 be advanced to E & R initial.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. Any further discussion? The question is the advancement of the bill. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. In the North balcony, Senator Duis, we have some friends from Cozad. We have 34 junior and senior high students from that fine city. That is in Senator Duis' district. Thank you for being with us this morning. LB 347.

CLERK: Read title to LB 347. There is a minor amendment offered by the Retirement Committee, signed by Senator Hasebroock.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hasebroock.
