

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I move that LB 530, as amended, be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. It is advanced.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I move the E & R amendments to LB 427 be adopted.

CLERK: That is an error on there.

SENATOR CULLAN: Then, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I move that LB 427, as amended yesterday, be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor.... What, then we don't have to advance 427? Alright.

CLERK: Mr. President, a motion on the desk. I move to return LB 530 to Select File for specific amendment. Signed, Senator Warner. There are a couple of specific amendments. I don't know if you want to combine these in one, or not. You have to return it each time.

SENATOR WARNER: Oh, combine them.

CLERK: Read amendment found on page 1727 of the Journal.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of both amendments. The first one you read dealt with a personal services limitation for the Ag Products Committee. The reason for adding it here was that limitation previously was in LB 532. The agency was proposed to be associated with the Department of Revenue. After Senator Lewis' amendment, last week, taking it out there this merely inserts that personal service limitation with the agency, now it remains as an independent agency. The second amendment is to lapse \$475,000 of cash funds in the Department of Banking to the General Fund. This is in the Securities Cash Fund. This has been building up over some period of time. The figure suggested here is one which the Department concurs in that could be lapsed. I think the last time it was done was three or four years ago. They will have adequate revenue from their cash receipts for the current year. In fact, they'll continue to rebuild a surplus. Needless to say with the shortage of revenue that we have in the General Fund this additional fund can be quite helpful. I would move that the bill be returned to Select File for both specific amendments.

PRESIDENT: The question then is.... Senator Dworak, your light is on. Did you want to be heard on this? The question then is shall the bill be returned for specific amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the two amendments as explained.
