

CLERK: Alright, now we still have the Kelly amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly will you close on the Kelly amendment.

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, Mr. President, I would close quickly so that we can use the Call of the House that we have, which would be simply this. The administration costs for SUN will be lowered now that they will be in with the Continuing Education Division. They have four learning centers spread across the state that they use for Continuing Education and for the SUN program and these can operate strictly under the Continuation division. Their selection of programs are going to be much more down to earth.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call Senators.

SENATOR KELLY: This is the whole purpose to get all of the administration over into the Continuing Education which is "Nebraska all the way". It would be separated, there would no longer be any ability to confuse the University of Mid-America and the State University of Nebraska, even though they are not together and haven't been for a long time, they are still considered to be one in the same. This says once and for all that our Continuing Education will run the TV programs, they can do it and with this small funding cut it will bother not one bit. In fact, it sends a message and sends it strong, we want TV education by the University of Nebraska, Lincoln and we want it tailored to Nebraska citizens and that is what this amendment is all about. I urge that you support this amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of Senator Kelly's amendment Record your vote. Have you voted? We are under Call. The Senators are to be at their desks. Record. Alright.

CLERK: Record vote. 21 ayes, 19 nays 9 excused and not voting. Vote appears on pages 1754-55 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Barnett moves that the Call be raised. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. I should advise the Senators that there will be another Call on the proposition, I think, based upon...so don't go too far. Senator Warner, I understand that Senator Merz has talked to you about taking up his motion to reconsider at this time. That you have no objections. Yes, but Senator Warner has agreed to allow Senator Merz to come in the middle of his presentation. So, at this time based upon your... and I have been advised by Senator Merz that there probably will be a Call of the House on this also, so, based upon that we go back now to motion 7b Senator Merz reconsider action on LB 64. Mr. Clerk. Vince do you have anything to read on this?

CLERK: The only thing pending is that Senator Merz moves to reconsider our action on LB 64.
