PRESIDENT: The motion is adopted.

CLERK: That is all I have Mr. President then on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 533 be advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. Record your vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a series of senators that have asked to have their names added to LR 70.

Mr. President, Education gives notice of hearing on May 9th for LB 540.

Mr. President, your committee on Retirement to whom was referred LB 343 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File as amended.

Mr. President, Senator Fowler asks unanimous consent to unbracket 232.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? Seeing none, it is so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 542 was introduced by the Appropriations Committee and signed by the members thereof (read bill).

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 542 be advanced, is that the one that is the amendment to LB 199? Vince?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR WARNER: This bill was introduced by the committee as a result of a departments request made on the passage of legislation, Senator Duis may have some comments on it. This is what the agency felt was required. It is difficult to know on some of these requests by an agency if the amount is what would be required, I think that it would be appropriate if Senator Duis would again refresh your minds, memories on LB 199 and how much additional work there may be, but the agency insisted that they could not meet the requirements within their existing budget and the bill introduced by the committee was to provide the opportunity for the body to review that question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: (no response).

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is the advancement of LB 542. Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes 0 nays on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Lets go to LB 543.

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
