SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendment. This is an amendment relative to the overhead funds that I discussed twice, and it was in both bills and the word "each" should have been in the clarity, at least, that the \$500,000 is for "each" UNL and the Med Center, it could be construed as we are reading it here to mean \$500,000 in total for both campuses and it was intended to be for each. The same correction will have to be made in 533. I'll move that with E & R. I move adoption of this amendment to 543.

SENATOR WARNER: This...well the amount is in both bills at this level Senator Lamb. What it permits is to use these, where they are going out to seek federal grants, and if they receive them, that portion of federal grants that is authorized to be used within the department will not be reduced...the General Fund appropriation will not be reduced by that amount but also, they are prohibited from coming back in with a continuation budget next year to pick up only the overhead money.
