PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The ruling stands, Senator Barnett.

CLERK: There are no further amendments.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 7 nays.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries.

CLERK: There is an Attorney General's opinion which will be inserted in the Journal, addressed to Senator Newell.

PRESIDENT: We go to LB 263A.

CLERK: There are no other amendments or amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, just to arise to say that I would like it recorded that that was a slip of the thumb. I certainly do not support the bill that was just advanced. It is only because Nichol was here trying to press my button.

PRESIDENT: That is out of order. Make that in writing after this, Senator Lewis, if you want an explanation of vote. Yes sir. Make your explanation in writing. Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I move that LB 263A be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

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
