SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, I would like to ask unanimous request to have this expedited. I will not be here the last two days of the Legislature and I would like to have an opportunity to vote on it.

PRESIDENT: Everything is expedited.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Do we go to LB 518 now? Mr. Speaker. All right, LB 518.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 518 was advanced to Select File. There are E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, I request of the Clerk. I had a motion to reconsider our action on LB 236, could you tell me what priority that takes or what happens? I will direct it to the Speaker.

PRESIDENT: I think that should be taken...all right, do you want to respond?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I would just say it is not going to be taken up today. We already have taken a half of the afternoon by a change unless you want to change the Speaker's order again. Go ahead.

SENATOR MILLS: I didn't move that into a motion, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: That is all right if you want to but that is the only way it is going to be done because I am not going to...

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Schmit has been recognized.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, are the E & R amendments up for adoption? Is Senator Cullan here? If not, I move they be adopted.

PRESIDENT: All right. Discussion? The question is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 518. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The ayes have it.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have rather a substantial number of amendments. The first amendment is offered by Senator DeCamp. It is found on page 1670 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I have up there an amendment called "Substitute". I wrote "Substitute" on it. It was turned in within the last ten or fifteen minutes. I want to pull every amendment and only have the one called "Substitute" because it incorporates everything we want to do. I want to briefly discuss these amendments and then ask to withdraw them.
