LB 204A, 232, 524, 522

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 232 and recommend it be replaced on Select File, no, no, that the bill is correctly enrolled.

PRESIDENT: Do we have an A bill on this to advance? While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and have signed LB 232. Do you want to move the A bill, Senator Merz?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 204 A introduced by Senator Merz of the 1st District. Read title.

SENATOR MERZ: Mr. President, I make a motion we advance the A bill, 204A.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. Record your vote. Please vote. This is the A bill. It is on General File. It takes 25 to move the bill. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The A bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, a communication on the desk from the Executive Office under date of May 6, 1977. Read. (See page 1879 and 1880, Legislative Journal.) Mr. President, your enrolling Clerk reports that she did on this day present to the Governor LB 232. Mr. President, Senator DeCamp asks unanimous consent to print amendments in the Journal to LB 534. Mr. President, Senator Barnett wants to be excused this p.m. Senator Marvel asks to be excused until 2:30 p.m. That is all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Could we take up some of these Select File E & R's read, some with just E & R amendments.

CLERK: I didn't hear what you said.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Do we have any just E & R amendments that we can take up?

PRESIDENT: Senator Sam.

CLERK: Select, Mr. President, LB 522, there are E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Sam Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 522 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 522 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.
