

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: So we will go ahead then and read LB 290 on Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: LB 290 read on Final Reading.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1890, Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting and 2 absent and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 290 passes and the Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 390.

ASSISTANT CLERK: LB 390 read on Final Reading.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1891, Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes 3 nays, 3 excused and not voting and 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

Before I get to this, the Chair would like to take the opportunity to introduce former Senator Lester Harsh from McCook who is sitting under the North balcony. It will give us some relief between Final Reading, Les, if you will stand up and be recognized. Welcome back. Now the Clerk will read LB 390A on Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: LB 390A read on Final Reading.
