CLERK: Mr. President, your reference committee reports that they have referred LB 546 to General File. Signed Senator Marvel, Chairman and by the other members of the Appropriations Committee. Mr. President, a new bill, LB 198A introduced by Senator Maxey of the 46th District. Read title. SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I think that is in order. You are asking unanimous consent to unbracket. Any objection? 46. Any objection? So ordered. So that removes that cloud. Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, a question of the Chair.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Yes, sir.

SENATOR MILLS: Now as I understand it, we are taking the preference bills for the individual senators...

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: That is correct.

SENATOR MILLS: ...which we submitted sometime ago depending on individual circumstance. The particular bill that I was interested in, Mr. Speaker, had been chosen as a committee priority bill. It is a bill that I introduced. Now may I change my preference.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: And I was just going to announce this but I will entertain as we recess here anyone in this body that wants to change their individual preference, get it to me, bring it up in writing to me so that we can recompile the list. This was always my intent that you had the bill you want when we get to it. Since it was remote, there was no need to compile this list until we got to it because as you indicated some of them would have been taken up by committee bills. Time would take care of some of them. So there was no use to do it until we got ready to take them up. Since the issue is now joined, we are going to take them up this afternoon. Any of you who want to change your individual preference, make sure it is your bill, get me that change now and we will present you with a revised list after we take up this afternoon. Senator Savare, do you want to, Vince, do we have all the things put in, Senator Savare.

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
