SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is the amendment that Senator DeCamp offered a long time and he did give a very brilliant defense of it at that time and I think that it does allow concerned citizens an avenue to test the constitutionality of the law and it allows us to have some enforcement of the laws which this legislature passes. It is not a perfect system and it is not a perfect answer to everything, but it is not complicated and I do not think that it would be expensive. So, I would support the amendment.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is on the Cullan amendment to LB 46. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 15 nays.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion fails. The amendment is not adopted. Are there any other amendments?

CLERK: None.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Cullan, your light is on.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, even with the failure of that amendment I certainly do support the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Murphy, do you want to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR MURPHY: As expeditiously as possible, Mr. Chairman.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a second? The motion and the second is to advance LB 46 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays on the motion to advance.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is carried, the bill is advanced. Before we proceed in the south balcony there are 21 sophomores from New Castle High School in Senator Murphy's district. Would you stand so that we could recognize you. Glad to have you with us today. Now before we proceed to LB 114, the Clerk has some business to read.
