

Then the parts, in the second "whereas" and the third "whereas" would be stricken. What we would have is a recognition of a conversion to the metric system and the authorization of a study to determine the best means for the State of Nebraska to accomplish that. Then during that study time anybody with input could offer it. That would be my amendment.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to LR 84. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of the Chambers amendment to LR 84 vote aye. Opposed vote no. Voting aye, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted? Have you all voted? It needs 25 votes. Clerk record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is adopted. The motion carries. The amendment is adopted. The Chair recognizes....

CLERK: Well now, Mr. President, I think all it does is direct a study. I think the resolution should be sent to the Executive Board, should it not?

SENATOR MARVEL: Well we have to pass the resolution. Is that your understanding, Senator Savage?

SENATOR SAVAGE: It's asking for a study, but I think we still have to pass the resolution, as amended.

SENATOR MARVEL: If the amendment proposes a study then it automatically goes to the Executive Board. Is that right, Mr. Clerk? Okay.

SENATOR SAVAGE: I'll so move then.

SENATOR MARVEL: You don't need to move, Senator Savage. It's taken care of. The amendment automatically asked for a legislative study, which goes to the Executive Board for reference.

CLERK: Mr. President, motion on the desk.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. President, can I make one more last statement. I was talking to Senator Keyes, if he's in the room. Senator Keyes. We're not talking about the Continental Congress, we're talking about the present Congress which passed this Act in 1976. I wasn't around when the Continental Congress was in session. The present Congress did pass this act. We're faced with having to implement it.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 46 and recommend it be placed on Select File as amended, LB 340 Select File as amended. Signed, Senator Cullan, Chairman. Mr. President, a motion on the desk. (Read Warner motion found on page 1943 of the Journal).
