LB 509, 531

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, just to remind those that didn't get in on the conversation that this is an act that Congress passed, and we have to get in compliance. This goes into effect January 1, 1978. So it's very important that we pass this during this session.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The question is the adoption of the Maresn amendment to place LB 509 at the head of General File, when we get to General File, which, Senator Maresn, I believe should follow the pending bill because LB 75 was pending. When we get to General File it will follow 75. It is just so everybody understands what will happen. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, Mr. President, on motion to adopt.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The motion carries. Speaker will place that on the...that is placed on General File, right after LB 75. Senator Warner, we have a number of motions. To avoid double handling of bills as they go off on Final Reading we'd like to take up these motions now so we don't have to have E & R handle them twice. So let's take up, at this time so we can get that done, some of the motions pending on appropriations bills. Mr. Clerk, would you read the motions at this time.

CLERK: Read Warner motion found on page 1913 of the Journal regarding LB 531.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Warner, this is on 531, motion to return.

CLERK: Your motion to return 531 for specific amendment. It's found on page 1918 of the Journal.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 531 be returned to Select File for the specific amendment. What this amendment does is adjust the personal services limitations and the Supreme Court budget for the county court to reflect the 33 thousand, or the five additional employees that the body put on, in addition to what the committee had recommended. It also takes into account the personal services for the five that the committee had asked on it. It is essentially corrective to recognize what the majority of the body has voted to do.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any discussion? Motion then is to return LB 531 for the specific amendment, which is to apply that which we've already done.

SENATOR WARNER: I should add this has no impact on increasing or reducing the dollars.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: No impact. All those in favor of returning LB 531 for this specific amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay on motion to return.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 531 is returned. Senator Warner, we'll just take it up at this time.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, the specific amendment is as found on page 1918 of the Legislative Journal.

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
