a report detailing various alternative procedures by which classifications and reclassifications can be accommodated in the normal budget process. CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit asked unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 52. Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk reports that she did deliver to the Governor on this day at 2 o'clock LB 257, 257A, LB 536 and LB 544. Mr. President, Senator Warner asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 533, three separate amendments, and Senator DeCamp asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 131. Now, Mr. President, the next amendment we have up is offered by Senator Koch. It is found on page 1729 of the Legislative Journal. (Read in LR 94).
