LB 533

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I'd like to ask Senator Schmit a question.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Schmit, do you yield?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I yield, Mr. President.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Now the program you're removing is which one?

SENATOR SCHMIT: The food and nutrition program, nutrition rehabilitation.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: That's probably the one that effects the urban area. Is that correct?

SENATOR SCHMIT: There is one other one that effects the urban area, yes.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: You want to make this a clean agriculture bill, is that right?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Those of us on the farms eat also, Senator Lewis, but then I suppose you could call that....

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Probably, by comparison, not as much as I do.

SENATOR SCHMIT: ...and urban priority would be in order, I believe.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I'd like to ask Senator Kremer a question.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Kremer, will you yield?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: What is involved in item 12, in terms of how that expenditure is made, and what is the program? While you're waiting could we tack 33 onto this one and zoom them both by?

SENATOR MARVEL: It's already on.

SENATOR KREMER: Item 12 is the section that Senator Schmit is alluding to. The objective is to adopt nutritional educational materials for the needs of special interest groups--mentally retarded, emotionally disturbed, physically disabled, and so on. I think that takes all of us in the Legislature in.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I think I understand the drift of what Senator Schmit is doing. I support the Schmit amendment. By the elimination of this I think we can probably pick up a number of votes against it. I'd like to kill it anyway. So I support you, Senator Schmit.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there any other discussion on the Schmit amendment? Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: I just wanted to speak to Senator Lewis and advise him that it looks to me like the food and nutrition element in the urban areas is doing just fine.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there any other pertinent discussion to the Schmit amendment? Okay. We're going to vote. The motion is the Schmit amendment to the Kremer amendment to LB 533. It needs 25 votes. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.

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
