

PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will please come to order. Roll call. Record your presence. Record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? There is an objection.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, I move to change the order of Final Reading, and that LB 33 will be read last.

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch, we're in the process of reading a bill. I don't think that your motion is in order and I think it's out of time.
