SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, I ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question is, shall the House go under Call. Record your vote on that. Record.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 1 nay.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call. Please return to the Chamber. Senator Kelly votes aye.

CLERK: Senator Kelly votes aye on the original motion.

PRESIDENT: Please record your presence.

CLERK: Senator Frank Lewis voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Would the Sergeant at Arms please round up the rest of the Senators. Have you all recorded your presence? We are under Call, Senators. We are under Call. Nonsentatorial personnel must be off the floor. The Board is open. The Clerk is open. Senator Barnett.

CLERK: Senator Barnett voting aye, changing from no to aye.

PRESIDENT: All right, report the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 13 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The amendment is adopted. Senator Carsten moves that the Call...here, we have a motion to recess until 1:30 p.m., Senator Luedtke.

CLERK: I have got to read some stuff in, Mr. President, but you need to raise the Call anyway.

PRESIDENT: Shall the Call be raised? Record. Call is raised. Read that in.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 33 and find the same correctly enrolled, 182 correctly enrolled, 263 correctly enrolled and 263A correctly enrolled. Signed Senator Cullan, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and have signed LB 33, 182, 263 and 263A. Mr. Speaker.

CLERK: Mr. President, Legislative Resolution 106 will be referred to the Executive Board, 107 referred to the Executive Board. Your Enrolling Clerk reports - read. (See page 2032, Legislative Journal.) Senator Duis asks unanimous consent to print amendments in the Journal. Senator Schmit asks unanimous consent to print amendments in the Journal. Senator Carsten asks to be excused this afternoon.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I move we recess until 1:30 p.m.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. We are in recess until 1:30 p.m.
