

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I've got a motion up on the desk. What I'd like to do is to amend Senator Swigart's motion. Vince, you might take that. I'm going to move to amend his motion that we take all the priority bills on General File and move them to E & R initial for the purpose of everybody in here, if you run short, it's only 22 or 23 bills. That way you won't have to go through and pick up each one, or pick up another one. Just the ones on priority list. Just the priority list on General File. Just the priority list on General File, the ones...just that he's got right on your worksheet today; individual priority bills.

PRESIDENT: I would entertain that motion on its own, but not as an amendment to Senator Swigart's.

SENATOR BARNETT: He's talking about the same subject-matter isn't he, Mr. President?

PRESIDENT: No, it's not an appropriate amendment. But I will entertain that later.

SENATOR BARNETT: Poor baby.

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, I move the previous question.

PRESIDENT: Do I see five seconds? I do. The question is shall debate now cease on Senator Swigart's motion. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 4 nays.

PRESIDENT: Senator Swigart, would you favor us with one of your scintillating closing arguments. Might be your last one.

SENATOR SWIGART: The motion before us is to overrule the Speaker's schedule, and to take up 402 at this time.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 19 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. What is the next matter?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 52A is an A bill that was put in by Senator DeCamp, on this date. LB 52, the basic bill, was advanced this morning.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Who moves its advancement?

CLERK: Senator DeCamp.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Record your vote on that motion to advance 52A. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, Mr. President.
