PRESIDENT WHELAN: All rise for the morning prayer.

DR. OHMAN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will be in order. Roll call. Record your presence. Mr. President, Senator Warner asked to be excused this A.M., Senator Frank Lewis and Kelly until they arrive.

PRESIDENT: Under the South balcony is former Senator George Fleming of the 37th District, Sidney, Nebraska. Senator Fleming, would you stand and be recognized. We also have in the South balcony 12 second through sixth graders from Saunders County, District # 5. That is in Senator Schmit's District. Thank you for being here.
