I have heard the problems that it is to land in some of these small town airports where specific commissioners happen to live. I think that they also happen to get their expenses, so they have transportation, expenses and on top of that we are now talking about a per diem. I think that the \$15 is adequate and I still think that this is a good place to stop just like we did two weeks ago. I haven't yet heard any new arguments to change my mind.
